

#### WHAT WENT ON LAST WEEK?

On April 24, 2021, a Black H&H Cargo trailer was stolen from 3 street Black Diamond. The trailer is described as being 7X14 with a v-nose and rear ramp door. Foothills Country RCMP have obtained video surveillance showing a dark colored Ford F-150 taking the trailer. This matter is still under investigation and anyone with information regarding this criminal offence is urged to contact the Foothills County RCMP, Turner Valley office.

Sometime overnight on April 25, 2021, unknown suspect(s) broke into a commercial storage unit on 393 Avenue E, Foothills, breaking into several storage units and stealing various items. Video surveillance was obtained showing a dark colored Dodge Caravan with three occupants. This matter is still under investigation and if anyone has information regarding this crime, are urged to contact the Foothills County RCMP, High River office.
