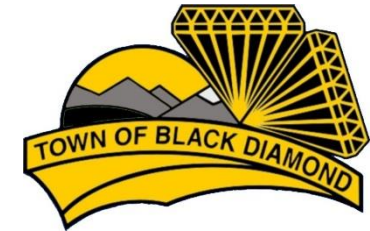

The Town Office

One of the very first things you need to do as a new resident is let us know who you are. The Town requires that you, as a new resident, advise us of your up to date contact information. *Before you come visit us, you'll need to obtain a post office box.* A trip to our local Canada Post office will ensure you receive a post office box. Mail is delivered to your post office box as opposed to your street address.

The Town provides the following services:

Utility Billing

Water/Sewer/Garbage/Recycling is billed bi-monthly. For your added convenience there is an automatic withdrawal plan available. Please call the Town Office for details or email

Garbage Pickup

The Town is participating in a Pilot Project with the Town of Okotoks for regional garbage collection services from June through November 2020. All garbage is collected during this time on Thursdays only. Please have your garbage put out for collection by 7:00 am in the cart which was provided by the Town. Black garbage carts belong to the residence not the owner. If your residence does not have a black cart or if you have any questions, please call the Town Office. You can also visit our website.

Recycling/Composting

Some other important information for living in the Town of Black Diamond is as follows:

Public Order Bylaw

The town respects the privacy of an individual and believes that others should as well.

Quiet hours are:

Monday to Saturday 10pm until 7am

Sundays & Holidays 10pm until 9am

Traffic Bylaw

Please note that within the Town's downtown core, a 2 hour parking limit is in effect from 8:00 am – 4:00 pm. Monday to Saturday. The Town provides free parking at 4 public lots. One is located east of the traffic lights on Centre Avenue, two at the Town Office (one on Centre Avenue and one in the alleyway behind) and another on 1 Street SW (across from the Medical Clinic).

Snow and Ice Removal

All persons owning or occupying premises in Town shall clear and remove snow and ice from the sidewalk adjacent to their property within 24 hours of the snowfall.

Animal Bylaw

Up to 3 dogs per household are permitted but must be licensed. A license can be purchased at the Town Office.

The Town offers an off leash area at the north end of 2 Street NW for you to walk your dog. In all other areas, except while on your property, the dog(s) must be on a leash. Please practice responsible pet ownership. The full bylaw is on the [website](#) or at the Town office.

Unightly Bylaw
