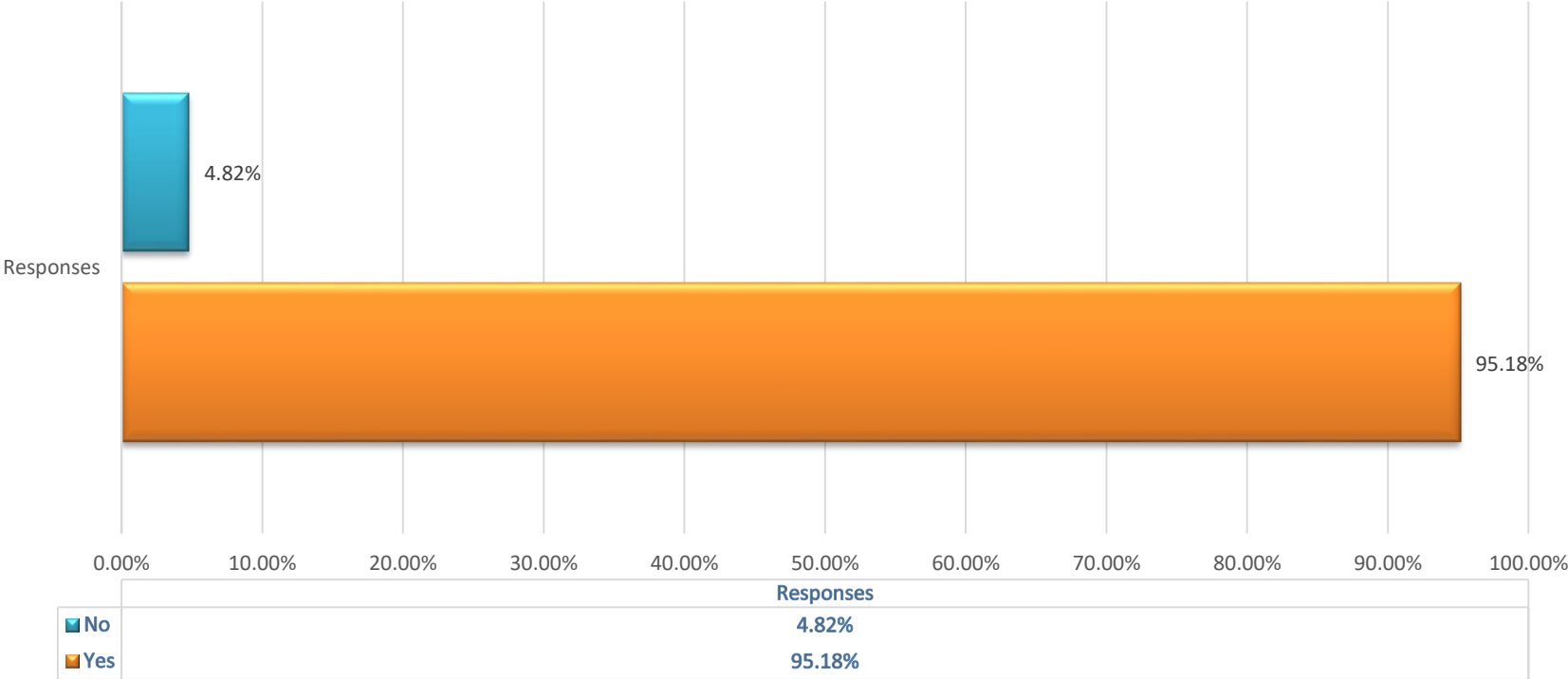

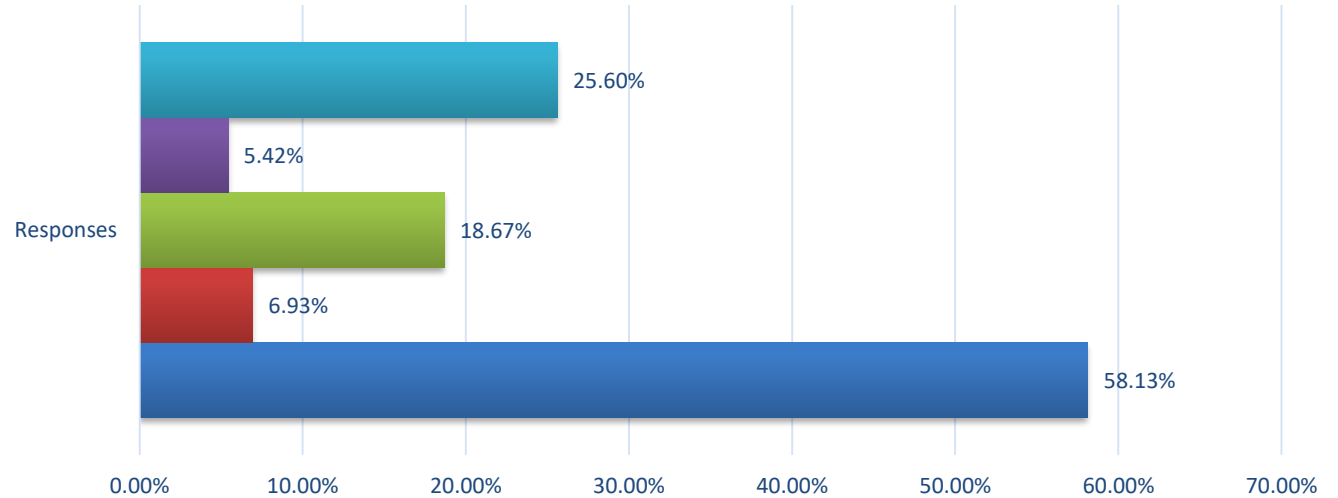
Q1: Do you live in Black Diamond?

Q2: In your opinion, should RVs be allowed to park in front yards? Please check all statements that you agree with.

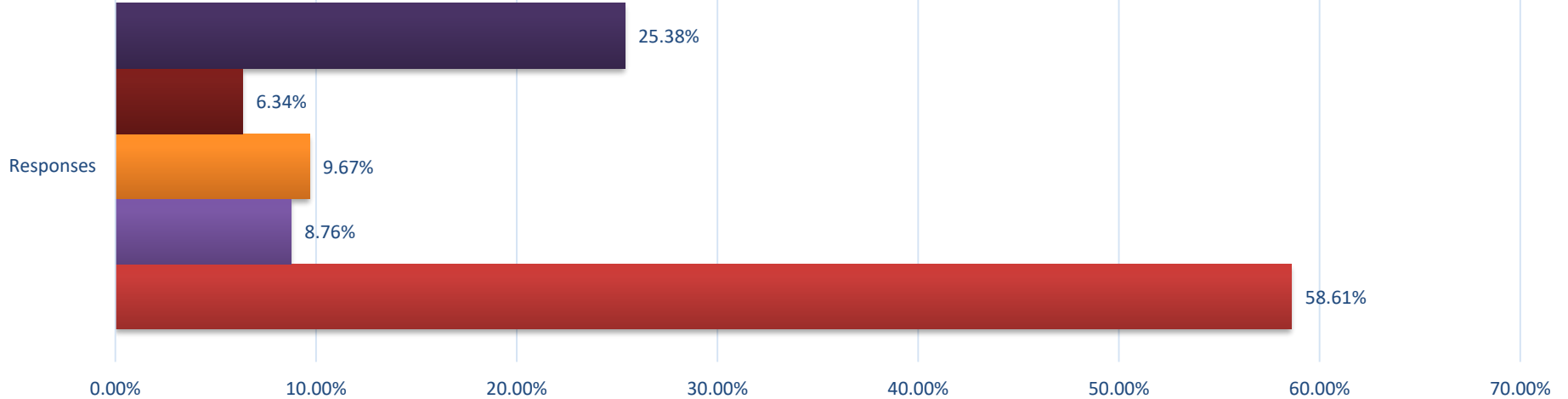
